



Your Utility Bill DeMISTified

Outside City Limits

Clear away the fog surrounding the water tier structure, learn how your rates are calculated, and get help keeping your water bill low.

Water Tiers Made Clear

Based on single-family lots outside city limits. Water rates effective January 1, 2025.

Tier 1 | Indoor Water Use

Tier 1 reflects the amount of water allotted for your home's indoor use. This is based on the monthly average amount of water used in your household from November through February. This is called your Average Winter Consumption (AWC). **If your use hasn't exceeded your AWC, your rate will be \$10.49 per 1,000 gallons.**

Tier 3 | High Level Water Use

If your bill shows that you are in Tier 3, your use has exceeded the amount of water that has been allocated for outdoor use. Tier 3 allotment is 20,000 gallons. **If your use exceeds your AWC plus your MOA, you will be charged a rate of \$15.74 per 1,000 gallons.**

Tier 2 | Outdoor Water Use

Your outdoor water use is allocated using a Monthly Outdoor Allowance (MOA) based on lot size. **If your use hasn't exceeded AWC plus your MOA, your rate will be \$10.49 per 1,000 gallons.**

Tier 4 | Excessive Water Use

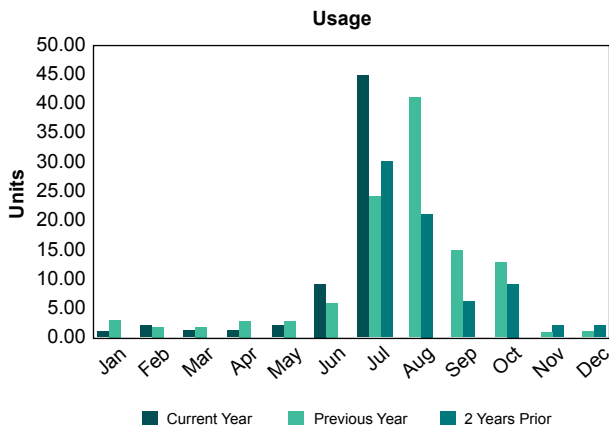
If your water use exceeds your total Tier 1-3 allocation (AWC+MOA+20,000 gallons) **you will be charged a rate of \$31.47 per 1,000 gallons.**

Why Use Tiers? The tiered rate structure provides a water budget for a range of lot sizes and encourages efficient use of Thornton's water supply.

Lot Size Appendix

Lot size is calculated based on Adams County Land Valuation Summary records. The Adams County measurement is acres, so the value is multiplied by 43,560 to convert to square feet.
